

Sock Snowmen

Materials Needed:

- White socks
- Rice or cotton balls for stuffing
- Rubber bands or string
- Colorful buttons
- Ribbons
- Scissors
- Fabric or permanent markers
- Orange pipe cleaners or felt for the nose



Instructions:

Fill the Sock: Take a white sock and cut it right where the heel starts to create a tube. Turn it inside out and fill it with rice or cotton balls to form the snowman's body. For a firmer snowman, rice is recommended.

Form the Body: Once filled to the desired size, tie off the top with a rubber band or string. Then, add another rubber band about two-thirds of the way up to form the head and body.

Decorate: Use fabric or permanent markers to draw eyes, a mouth, and buttons down the front. Glue colorful buttons over the drawn ones if you prefer a 3D look.

Nose: Cut a small piece of orange pipe cleaner or felt into a triangle to make a carrot nose. If using pipe cleaner, you can insert it directly into the sock. If using felt, glue it on.

Scarf: Take a colorful ribbon or cut a strip from another sock to create a scarf. Tie it around the snowman's neck where the head and body meet.

Hat: If you want to add a hat, use the cut-off toe part of the sock, roll it up to form a beanie, and place it on the snowman's head. Secure with glue if necessary.

Final Touches: Add any additional decorations you like, such as sewing a small bell on the hat or adding a broom made of a stick and pipe cleaners.
