8. **Metafiction**: The book refers to a manuscript that seems to foretell the events of the novel. How does this affect your interpretation of the story?
9. **Sexuality and Love**: The characters in the novel have complicated love lives, some even taboo. How do these relationships affect the family and the story?
10. **Ending**: What did you think of the conclusion of the Buendía family's story? Was it satisfying? Surprising? Inevitable?
